# ABC Training & Coaching

ABC T&C equips BDS providers to:

- 1) deploy proven partnership facilitation methods and tools.
- 2) bring FOs, Agri-SMEs and local BDS providers together and facilitate:
  - Joint diagnosis of the business situation & design of strategic action plans
  - Field coaching, collective learning & decision making in learning cycles
  - Relationships building & management (conflict handling, negotiation)

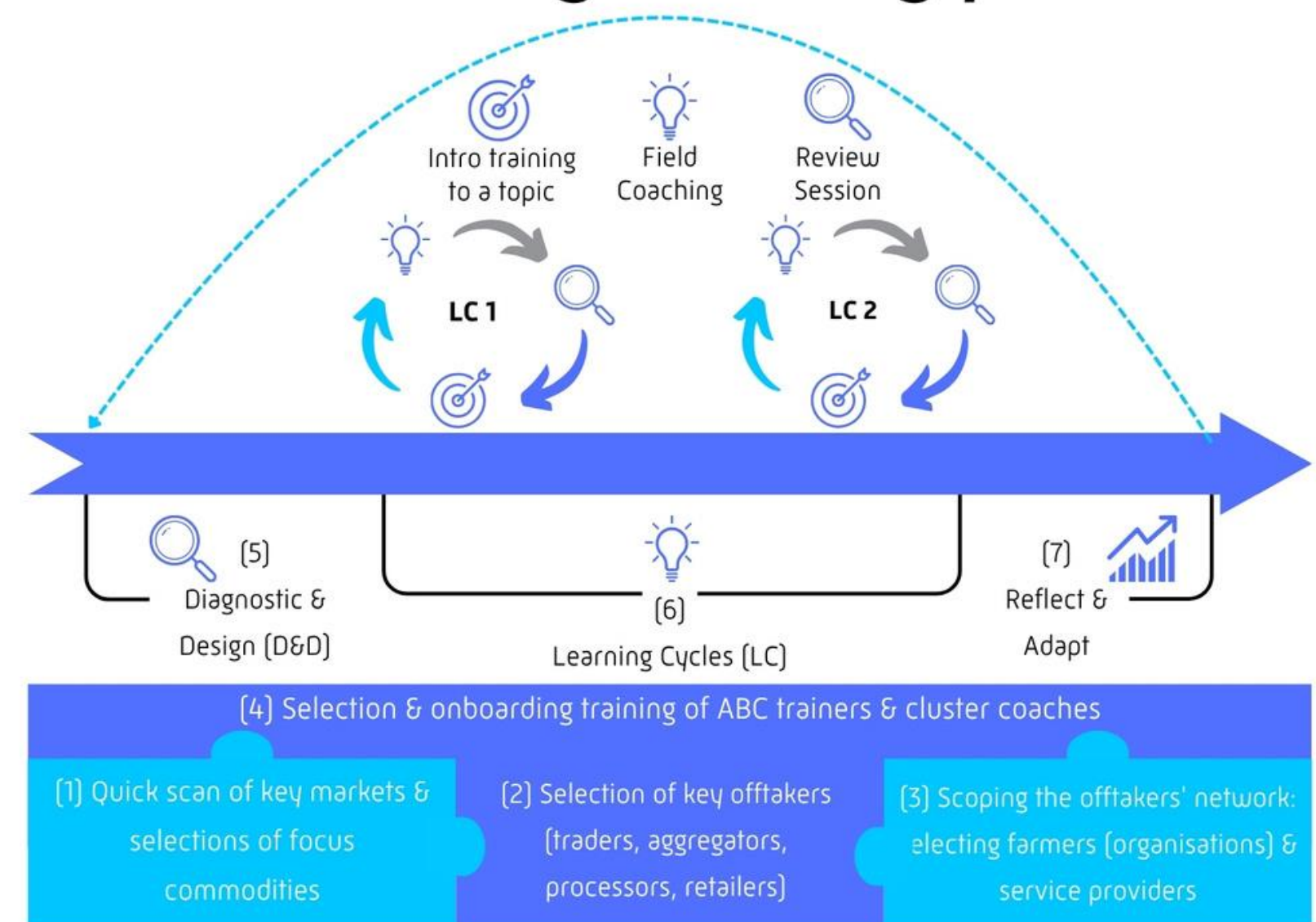

## ABC Training & Coaching year 1



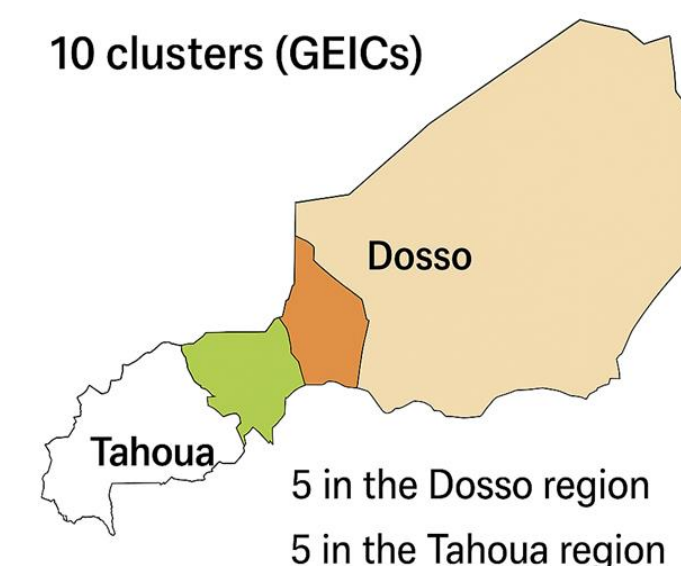


## ABC Training & Coaching in Practice

- 10 clusters in Niger (4 dairy, 3 poultry, 3 red meat)
- 14 traders/aggregators & 50 farmer organizations selected (Enabel)
- 2 master trainers & 23 coaches trained
- Diagnostic & Design workshops turned into 10 cluster action plans
- 4 learning cycles completed within 15 months (facilitation techniques, conflict handling, negotiation, contracting)
- Reflect & Adapt workshops to adjust focus in year 2

Outcomes end of year 1\*:

- 3800 farmers/SMEs clustered
- Volume traded:
  - 18000 poultry transformed
  - 200000 liters of dairy processed
- 150 signed contracts
- Loans mobilized: 140 million CFA (200.000 Euro)
- \* % increase tbd end of year 2
