
ABC Training & Coaching in Pratice

- 10 clusters in Niger (4 dairy, 3 poultry, 3 red meat)
- 14 traders/aggregators & 50 farmer organizations selected (Enabel)
- 2 master trainers & 23 coaches trained
- Diagnostic & Design workshops turned into 10 cluster action plans
- 4 learning cycles completed within 15 months (facilitation techniques, conflict handling, negotiation, contracting)
- Reflect & Adapt worskhops to adjust focus in year 2

- Outcomes end of year 1*: • 3800 farmers/SMEs clustered • Volume traded:
 - \circ 18000 poultry transformed
 - O 200000 liters of dairy processed
- 150 signed contracts
- Loans mobilized: 140 million CFA (200.000 Euro)
- * % increase tbd end of year 2
